TITLE: The Effect of COVID19

ABSTRACT

Despite ongoing research and recent discoveries, there remains a paucity of data regarding COVID-19 and its implications for pregnant women, particularly its effects on the developing fetus. To date, there are a limited number of articles available regarding the utility of Extra Corporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO) for cardio-respiratory support of pregnant women during the perinatal period. Additionally, there are only a few case reports detailing the delivery management of a baby born to a mother on ECMO support. NICU admissions, prematurity, low birth weight, and cesarean section are common expectations with deliveries in mothers with SARS CoV-2. The risk of preterm delivery is 20%. The neonate born to a mother with SARS-CoV-2 needs to be tested for reverse transcriptase-polymerase chain reaction (RT-PCR) for SARS-CoV-2 at 24 and 48 to 72 hours of life. Neonates should be assessed for clinical features of SARS-CoV-2 infection, such as fever, cough, nasal congestion, respiratory distress, decreased activity, and feed intolerance. ECMO use during pregnancy theoretically can be associated with a high risk for maternal and fetal bleeding complications. Here, we report a case of a premature, low birth weight neonate delivered by a 32-year-old woman while on ECMO due to severe acute respiratory distress syndrome resulting from COVID-19 infection.
